Kanya Mahavidyalaya, the higher education institution for girls, situated at Geetanagar, Guwahati-781021(Assam) has been imparting education up to graduate level since 16th September, 1977. The college has been established by the effort of a group of educationists and social workers of Pub-Guwahati area which started its academic activities at Pub-Guwahati Girls' High School and administrative activities at the residence of Suchibrata Raichoudhury, recipient of Sahitya Academy Award. Khanindra Chandra Barua and Suchibrata Raichoudhury were the first President and the Secretary of the Governing Body of the college respectively. Noted educationist and a recipient of Padmashri Award recipient Indira Miri was appointed as the first Principal of the college.

The college thereafter operated its academic purposes in a rented house located at Zoo-Road, Guwahati since 15th November 1977. The college has been shifted to its permanent campus of 10 bighas at Geetanagar hill top in 1987. An Assam-type house has been constructed with the effort of local enthusiast people which is being used as an extended campus at present. The college is at present functioning in its new campus behind Geetanagar High School on Mother Teresa Road, Geetanagar, Guwahati-21

A three-storied building has been constructed with the aid of Guwahati Refinery, Guwahati-20 and Govt. of Assam in the new campus and it has been used for academic purpose.



The college accommodates 135 students in each year of Higher Secondary and 250 students in different honours courses. An additional 150 students are accommodated for general B.A. course. During the Academic Year 2021-2022, the enrollment of the students in the H.S. course is 202 and in B.A. course is 278.

the application form for admission. Any application form without valid caste certificate will be considered under general category.

REGULATIONS OF THE UNDER GRADUATE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (UGCBCS) GAUHATI UNIVERSITY, 2019

(AS AMENDED ON 8/11/2019)

1. THE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The Choice Based Credit System is the logical next step in a credit based semester system becoming more learner-centric. A CBCS offers the student a diversity of courses to choose from and the autonomy to decide on the place, pace and time of learning. The UGC has recommended that it is desirable for all institutions of Higher Education in the country to move to a CBCS and together with it, implement a uniform grading system.

2. UNDER GRADUATE CBCS (UGCBCS) PROGRAMMES

The undergraduate degree programme in the CBCS will have courses spread across six-semesters. A typical semester will comprise a minimum of 15 to 18 weeks of academic work that will translate into 90 actual teaching days. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic Session- June to May). The duration of the of the Odd Semesters (First, Third and Fifth) shall be 'June to November', and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth and Sixth) shall be 'December to May'.

The dates and duration mentioned in the academic calendar concerned will be in consonance with the above schedule as far as practicable.

Each student must take admission in three consecutive Academic Sessions starting with the first semester. Students who do not enroll in the Second Academic Session will not be eligible to take admission in the Third Academic Session.

The minimum time requirement to acquire an undergraduate degree will be three years. The maximum time allowed to complete the programme will be six years.

Structure of courses and credits of the UGCBCS programmes:

The term undergraduate degree programme denotes programmes like B.A.

The academic work in each semester will require the student to engage with chosen courses, the content which will be described in detail in the syllabi. Every course will have defined learning objectives and may be designed to comprise lectures, tutorials, laboratory work, field work, project work or any other activity that addresses the learning objectives of the course.

Each course will have credits, assigned on the basis of course related activities, which a student will earn through satisfactory fulfillment of the academic requirement of the course.

An undergraduate degree program with Honours in a discipline will have a course credit requirement of 148 credits while an undergraduate degree programme without Honours will require a student to earn 132 course credits in a Honours programme can opt to earn additional credits by undertaking additional Elective courses to the condition that the total number of course credits does not exceed 160 credits. For a student in a Regular program, the credit ceiling will be 140 credits. The credits earned beyond the mandatory program requirement will not be taken into consideration in computation of the student's grade but will be recorded in the grade sheet.

The medium of instruction and examination will be English and/or Assamese, except in language courses.

Any application form without valid caste certificate will be considered under general category.
- D. **A maximum 5% of the seats are earmarked as per break up given below for outstanding Sports Persons/NCC Cadets/Scouts & Guides, proficiency in cultural activities, wards of the employees of the college etc.**
 - i) **2% for sports persons of sports recognized by IOA/ SAI and also for candidates who have represented district/ State etc.**
 - ii) **1% for wards of employees of the college.**
 - iii) **1% for the NCC/ Scouts & Guides.**
 - iv) **1% for the students with achievements in cultural activities.**
- E. No claim for caste benefit will be entertained if the original caste certificate issued by the appropriate authority and countersigned by the DC/ADC/SDO/SDC concerned is not produced at the time of physical verification of documents.
- F. **For the purpose of confirmation of admission into B.A 1st semester courses, candidates are required to produce the following in original for physical verification:**

- Recent coloured passport size photograph.
- Mark sheet of last examination passed.
- Migration Certificate in case of CBSE and Other Boards students.
- Caste certificates from competent authority wherever necessary.
- Students passing the qualifying examination earlier than the current year will have to submit a Court Affidavit (Candidates having a gap period of more than 3 years are not eligible for admission as per the guidelines issued by GU).
- For students admitted under Specially abled **Category** : Minimum 40% disability certificate.


